The Room Sculpture Experience is a collaborative art making experience in which students build and then deconstruct a unique physical sculpture made from a series of curated objects, set pieces, fabrics, and lighting fixtures. A guide will lead the students through an hour-long experience by providing creative prompts and will lead a debrief afterwards. The Room Sculpture Experience takes place in a fully immersive theatre environment using a suite of lighting, projection and sound design to inspire participants to give over to the creative impulse. Participants will be asked to remain silent throughout, with the goal of energizing the imagination, inspiring creative practice, and building community through collaborative art making.
